Test concept for schools

Information for parents and students

- From 19.04.2021 you can only go to school if you have been tested for COVID-19
- That is valid only when your presence is required at school (Präsenz-Unterricht)
- You must get tested twice a week, ideally in the morning before leaving for school
- The first test is always on the first school day after home schooling or the weekend
- The second test day is determined by the school
- You can do the tests yourself at home
- The schools provide the tests to students, usually through the class teachers
- There are three important papers/forms that your parents or you (over 18) must fill out:
 1. Pick up of the tests (Annex 4, Page 2)
 - Please enter the school, data about the student and data about the parents
 - You **MUST** have this form in order to receive the home tests
 2. Carrying out the tests (Annex 2)
 - Bring this form to school with you on the required test days
 - Please enter every test in the table on page 2 including the day and time you tested
 - For students under 18: Parents must confirm the test – for every test, parents fill out the second row (Name, Date, Signature)
 3. Emergency testing in the school (Annex 3)
 - Keep this form with you **at all times**
 - This form is needed in case of emergency, if you forgot to test at home or forgot to bring the form confirming the test (Annex 2)
 - Then you can be tested in the school and do not have to go home

IMPORTANT:

- If you have not tested and do not have the form (Annex 3) to get tested at school, you are not allowed in the school!
