Declaration of consent to carry out SARS-CoV2 self-tests in school

In the state of Brandenburg there are testing regulations for attending schools. You can find the information here:

Students must take a test or self-test 2 days a week. There are 3 options:

- The students take the self-test at school.
- The students take a self-test at home then write the result on a form and bring it to school. The test must be less than 24 hours old.
- The students take a test at a test center, doctor's office or pharmacy. After the test you will get a document confirming the result. The students must bring this document with them to school. The test must be less than 24 hours old.

The school will give you the tests for the self-tests. The test must be negative. There must be an interval of at least one day between the 2 tests. A test is taken on the first day a student must attend school. Then there will be a day or two with no test. Then a second test is done.

The school stores students' names and birth dates. The school saves the test results (test positive, test negative). If the test is positive, you will be informed by the school. The school can text you or call you on the phone. In order to do this, the school needs you to fill out the information below and provide your signature. Please pass this information on to your child when they go to school.

You can withdraw your consent at any time. To do this, write a letter, email or fax to the school.
